





2019

- Otero Arts is incorporated and leases the former Woman's Club WPA era historical building at 12th & Indiana, now known as Otero Artspace
- The Fabulous Five Founders who worked together to create OA are Chris Jones, Chris Carson, Julia Cozby, Janet Amtmann and Claudia Powell—with generous donations from Joe Weidner

2020

- After renovations, OA moves into building
- COVID Health orders put in place, the new building is closed, and meetings are moved to Zoom
- Social media established; new brochure designed

2021

- Virtual Art show created and presented on Facebook
- NM health mandates eased, and OA opens for business
- First Open House and Art Show draws 100 attendees
- Ewetopia weaving group begins meeting
- Writers' Reading Group is formed
- First committees are formed; membership, programming & board membership expanded

2022

- First newsletter published
- Monthly Artist Exhibitions and First Fridays Opening Night Receptions launches for artists from Otero, Lincoln & Dona Ana counties
- Student Art Show gets 400 attendees at the reception
- Reading Series begins, featuring well-known writers including local author Michael McGarrity
- First classical concert featuring guitarist Gerardo Perez
- OA sponsors House Concerts, featuring national artists
- Bimonthly Movie Nights hosted
- Donors' Reception for members appreciation
- Monthly Meet n Greet begins for members
