

August/September

One of the items reported in the annual meeting was the awarding of a grant to OAI by the NM Arts Commission in the amount of \$4667. Chris Jones and Liliane Pilot wrote the grant last year. Plans for that money have resulted in the booking of two classical concerts in the future. Just another example of the diversity and volunteer enthusiasm producing quality artistry for people in Otero County and the realization of so many OAI volunteers' dreams and plans/ideas. The monthly artist exhibitions that have been happening at the Artspace for a good part of this year are going to be joined by a special one in September: Member Artists' exhibition! A great many of these artists who will be exhibiting have been tireless volunteers for OAI. Please make an effort to come during the show times (every Thurs through Sun, 1 -4 in September) and support your fellow members!

Annual meeting report:

Approximately 20+ OAI members met on June 28 for the first annual meeting of the organization. Chris Carson, as acting President, officiated and remarked to the group that OAI now has almost 100 members

Janet Amtmann gave the Financial Report: \$14K+ is in the bank, and it takes \$13K+ annually to keep the building open. She announced that a grant has been awarded in the amount of \$4667. The Board will be allocating those monies according to grant criteria for fiscal 2022-2023.

In the President's report, Chris also reported that OAI is supporting efforts to develop an Arts & Culture district. He also reported that several groups are now using the building weekly, such as the Alamo Expermental Theater group, and music with House Concerts each month. Art exhibitions have been and will continue to be held every month, featuring local and member artists' works for the public perusal.

Carson explained that he assumed the President's position from VP when Chris Jones, OAI founder, tenured out. He presented a gift of gratitude, a digitized photo of the building by Laurie Baker and framed by Janet, to Chris Jones for his tireless work in organizing and building OAI. He has worked on obtaining grants and leading OAI to what it is today. He also recognized and thanked the hardworking Board.

Pennie Espiritu, acting as chair of Nominating Committee, presented those nominated for the Board: Chris Carson, Chris Jones, Janet Amtmann, Judy Reeves, Rochelle Williams, and Pennie Espiritu. Claudia Powell was nominated from the floor. All were elected to the Board. The group then elected the President: Chris Carson, Vice-President: Maria Aragon; Secretary: Ann Beacht. Janet has been serving as Treasurer, but requested to be relieved of her duties so that she can concentrate on her work on the Membership and the Art Show committees. The Board will recruit a new Treasurer from the Board.

Notes on JULY meeting of the Board: (all meetings are on the 2nd Tuesday of each month and are open to members and others interested) OAI insurance agent met with Board and one of the discussion points was about liquor liability for the building; for the time being, until clarified, no liquor is allowed on the premises.

Treasurer's Report: \$14,578 in bank EOM, total expenses for month was \$983 and income was \$1640

Ann Beacht reported total volunteer hrs for 2nd quarter was 953 for total value of \$20,196. Ann also reported on membership committee and the Board approved a budget of \$30 for mo. meet and greet gatherings for members

Sue Kent reported on fundraising: \$768 from donations and raffle receipts from Nichols Cherry Festival booth. Also noted donation from LOCO CU for purchase of movie projector. The Board is working on getting the JR Willis paintings that originally hung in the Building returned.
