as we present New Mexico author Jennifer Bonhoff for a day of learning about how the war impacted the New Mexico territory. The event at Artspace will begin at 10 am and run until 4 pm. There will be a break for lunch on your own. (Feel free to bring along a sack lunch.)

Jennifer will address the following topics: Background to the war; Battle of Mesilla; Sibley begins his campaign; Battle of Valverde; Onward up the Rio Grande; Battle of Glorieta Pass; The Long Road Home.

This is Jennifer's second appearance at Artspace. She first came a couple of years ago to discuss her book series "Rebels Along the Rio Grande", a collection of young adult novels. These books were based on research she did on the war in New Mexico. This New Mexico native is a retired history teacher.





Donna Foley has been a weaver for over 30 years. She learned the craft in upstate New York, and for many years, she raised Lincoln sheep and still uses their lustrous yarn, which she dyes from local plants. Ms. Foley moved to NM in 2013 near the Gila National Wilderness.

Her tapestries are in galleries in Silver City and at art shows throughout the Southwest, including the NM Art & Craft Show and Las Cruces Fine Art Show and an exhibit at El Museo Cultural de Santa Fe.


Capdevila is a versatile guitartist known for his mastery of a wide range of musical styles, such as jazz, classical or contemporary.
