

OAI Celebrates Donors and Unveils Plaque to Honor them: On October 28, OA held a Donor Appreciation Reception at the Artspace. Approximately 25 donors and members came together to celebrate with food and collegiality the individuals and businesses that have given substantial financial support to OA in its fledgling years.

These generous donations, along with purchased yearly memberships, have helped furnish the former Woman's Club building and added equipment to make it more functional as the organization develops its programs and services.

Particularly since the ebbing of influence from Covid this year, the building has become a warm and welcoming environment in which to enjoy a variety of arts activities in this community. Donor contributions have allowed the purchase of tables, chairs, art panels, hangers and lighting, window shades, audio-visual equipment, a security system and a sign for the building.

The beautifully restored WPA-era building has become a hub for a wide range of artistic experiences, featuring regional artists and photographers, quarterly readings by New Mexican writers, bi-monthly movie nights, weekly rehearsals by an experimental theater group and numerous practice sessions by community musicians.
